

and to be presented with the server list as show below as the first screen when you ssh into the ezsh shell.

Navigate to *Account->Preferences*, select *Skip group menu* and choose *Go to group* from the drop down. Select *All Servers* if you want a list of all servers when you ssh to the ezsh shell.



Choose a different Server Group under Go to group to have different listing in the ezsh shell.
