Step 1: Open PuTTY and enter the Ezeelogin/Jumpserver IP or Hostname along with the Port

number. Click "**Open**" to initiate the connection.

Step 2. Provide your Ezeelogin username and password when prompted.



Step 3. If enabled, **enter the Security code or complete Two Factor Authentication** to access the Ezeelogin shell (ezsh).




Step 4. Upon successful authentication, you will enter the Ezeelogin shell (ezsh). The initial screen displays a **list of server groups**. Navigate through the list using **arrow keys** and

press Enter to select a server.
