

Get Started with Ezeelogin JumpServer.

Overview: This article describes how you can get started with Ezeelogin.

1. Ezeelogin GUI/ Web interface Login

• Go to the Ezeelogin web panel installed URL (configured during <u>installation</u>) using your web browser. Use the admin username and password that you provided during the Ezeelogin installation to log into the Ezeelogin web panel.



- 2. Ezeelogin backend shell (Ezsh shell).
 - You need to SSH into the Ezeelogin SSH gateway server as any Gateway user that was created.



• Click on the webssh icon as shown below and you will be able to SSH via browser.
