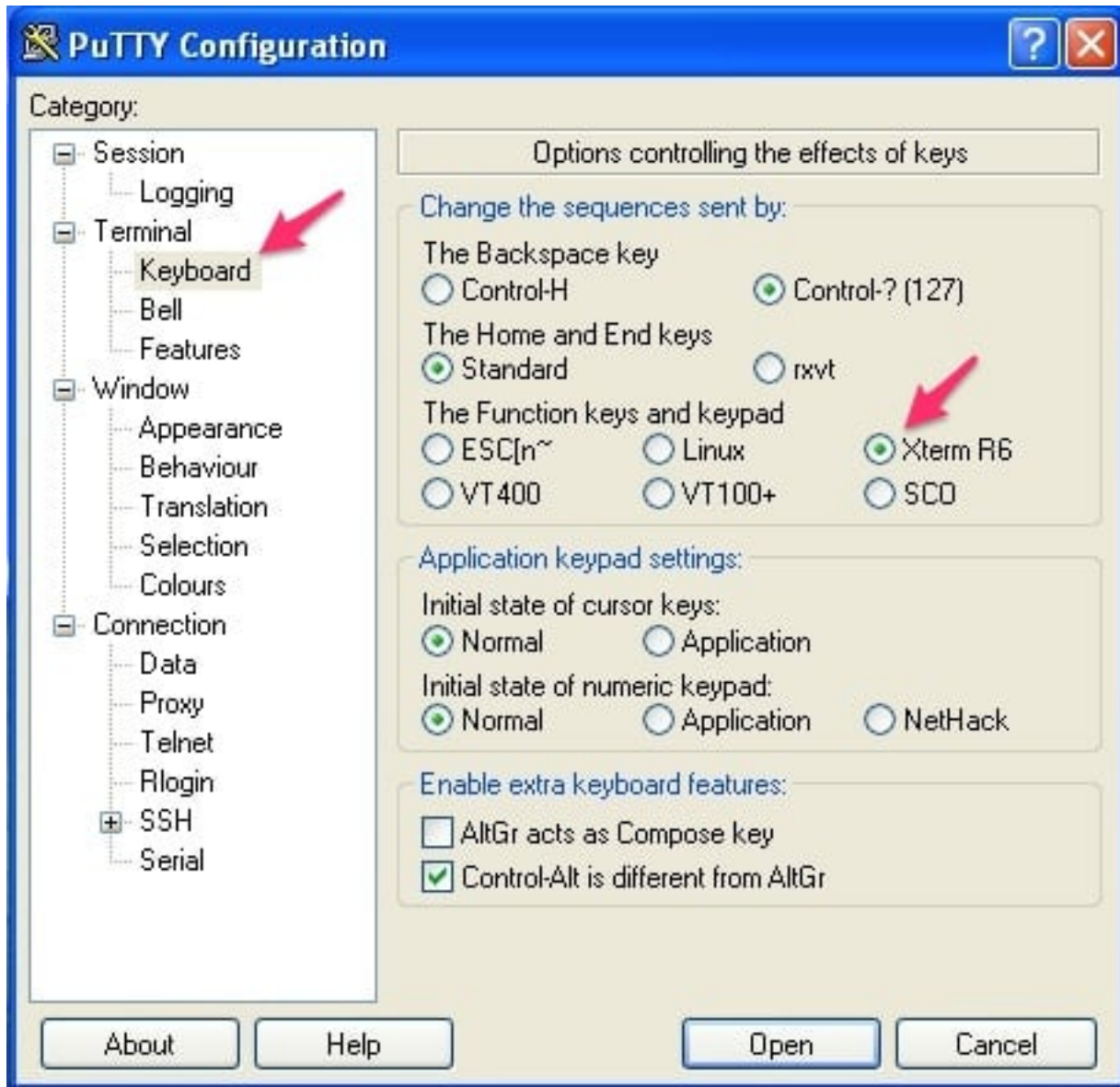

How to resolve the issue of F1-F4 keys not working in ezsh when using PuTTY?

Overview: This article provides a solution for gateway users facing problems with the F1-F4 keys while using ezsh when connecting through PuTTY.

Step 1: To fix the issue with the F1-F4 keys while using PuTTY, open the PuTTY configuration

window, navigate to **Terminal -> Keyboard**, and change the "**Function keys and keypad**" setting to "**Xterm R6**".
