


How to hide remote server passwords from non-privileged Ezeelogin gateway users?

Overview: This article helps admin privileged users to hide remote server passwords from non-privileged users on the Ezeelogin gateway.






Step 1: To prevent non-privileged gateway users from viewing remote server passwords from both GUI and backend, disable the "**View Password**" option in Access Control by navigating to **Access Control** -> **User Action**.



Once the "View Password" feature is disabled in Access Control, the password will no longer be visible to the user.
