How to add Cpanel as webportal?

Overview: This article describes the steps to add Cpanel as a web portal, including creating a group under Web Portals, adding WHM, configuring auto-login if needed, and saving the details to access the portal.

To add Cpanel as a web portal; follow the below steps to create a group for the web portal and later try to add the Portal.

Step 1: If there is no existing group, add a group under **Web Portals -> Groups** and then fill in the details of the Cpanel group.

Step 2: Add Cpanel under **Web Portals**.

Step 3: In order to use **Auto Login**, Paste the login URL and fetch the details of the Cpanel using the **Fetch details** button so that the details of the Cpanel automatically get fetched.

Step 4: After giving all the details **Save** it and access the web portal as follows:-
