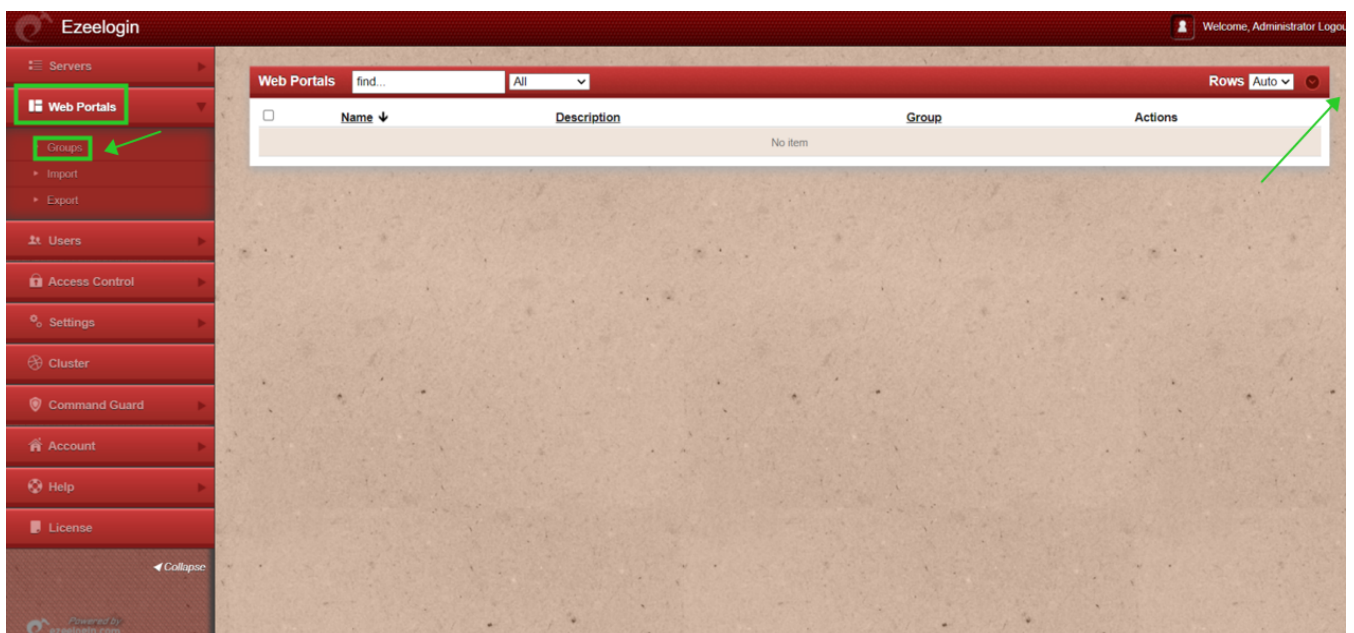

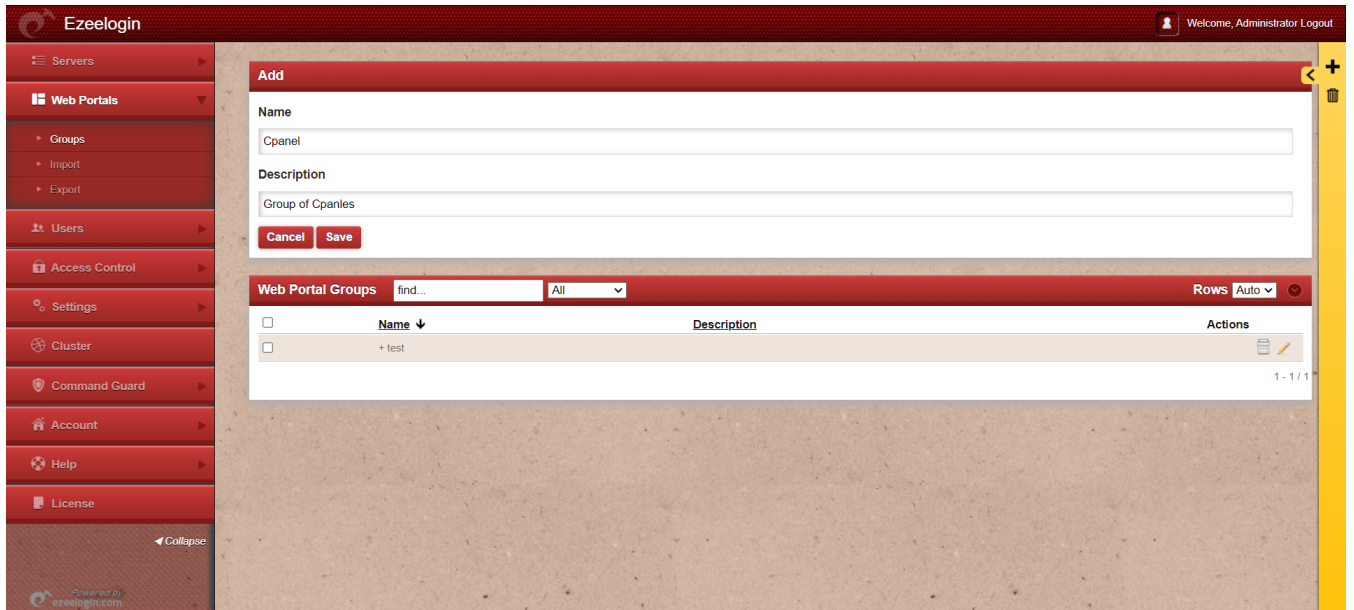

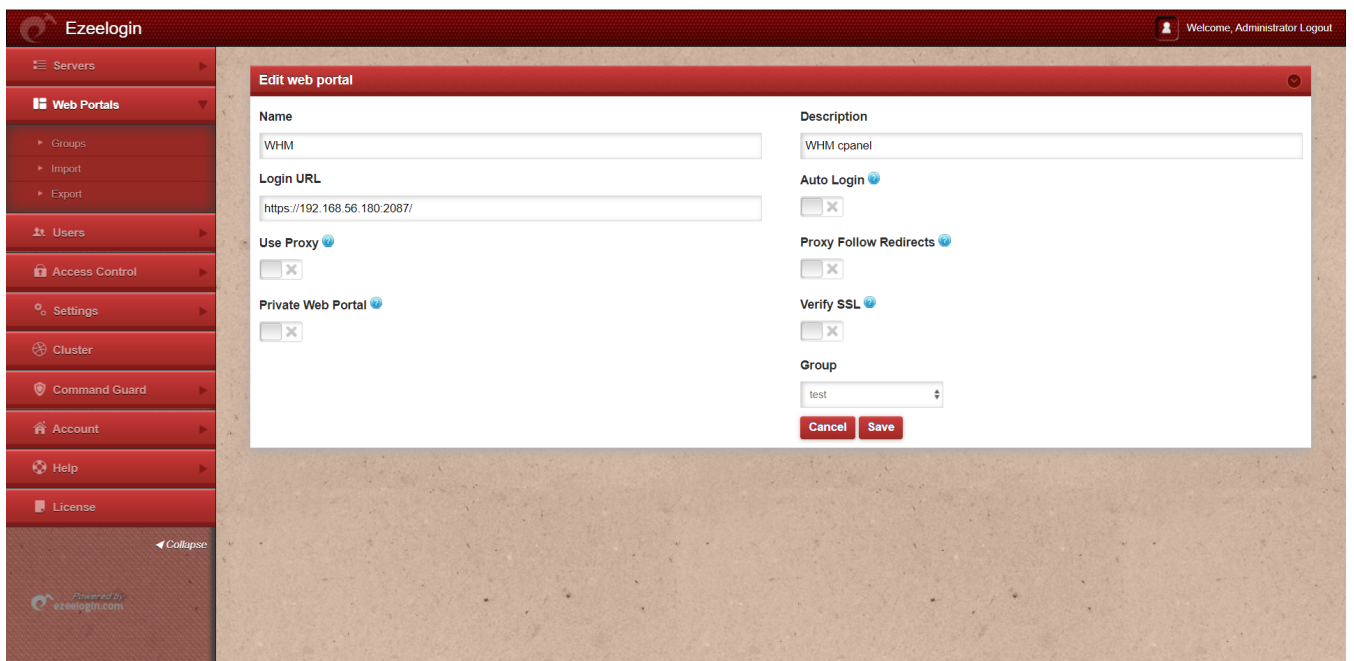
To add Cpanel as a web portal; follow the below steps to create a group for the web portal and later try to add the Portal.

1. If there is no existing group, add a group under **Web Portals -> Groups** and then fill in the details of the Cpanel group.





2. Add WHM under **Web Portals**.



3. If you are using **Auto Login**,

Paste the login URL and fetch the details of the Cpanel using the **Fetch details** button so that the details of the Cpanel automatically get fetched.

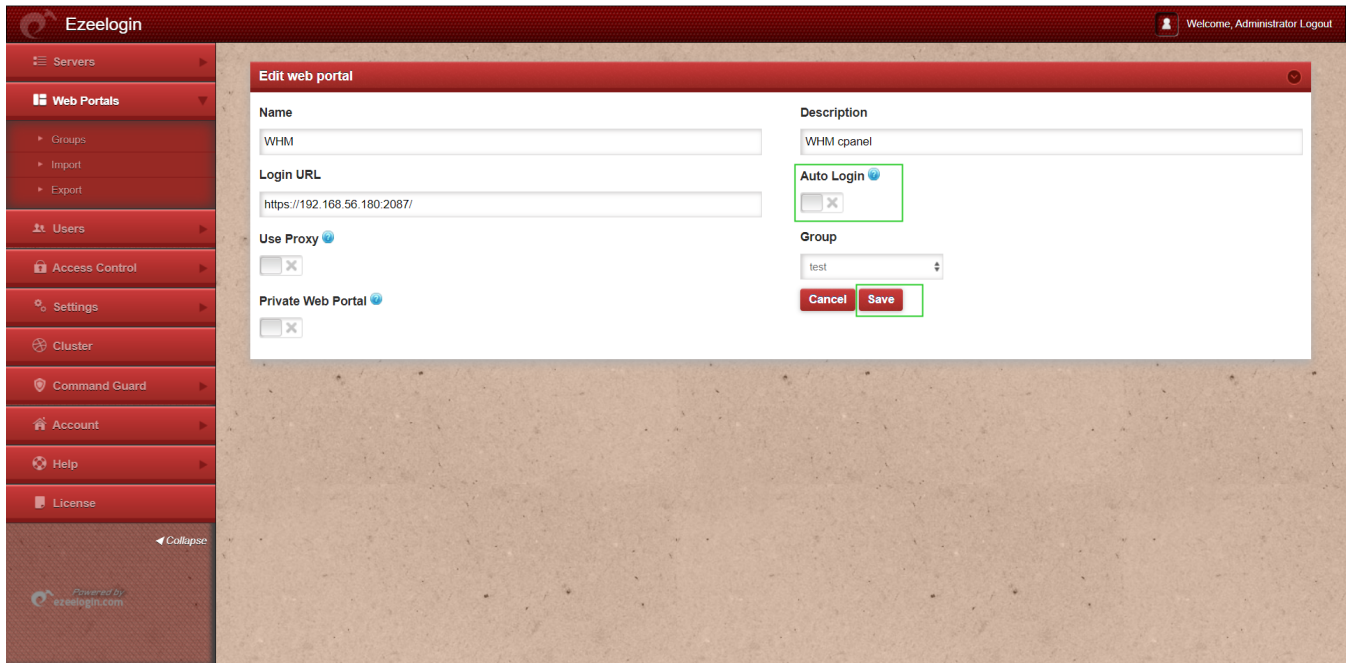
