


The error occurs if you have enabled the <u>Use DNS</u> which indicates the following.

- Use DNS Server specific override for Use DNS setting.
- Inherit Inherit global setting
- Yes Use DNS irrespective of the global setting
- No Do not use DNS irrespective of the global setting.

Step 1: From Servers tab -> Edit Server -> Advanced section -> Change Use DNS (yes) -> (Inherit) and try to re-login.



Step 2: To change the setting globally Go to Setting -> General -> Miscellaneous -> Disable Use DNS and try to re-login
