## CHANGE MAPPED SUBSSH GROUP

**Overview:** This article explains how to change the mapped group of a Sub SSH user in Ezeelogin and outlines the effect of changes on active SSH sessions.

For instance, currently, the [Sub SSH user](#) Martin is under User Group Admin\_Servers.

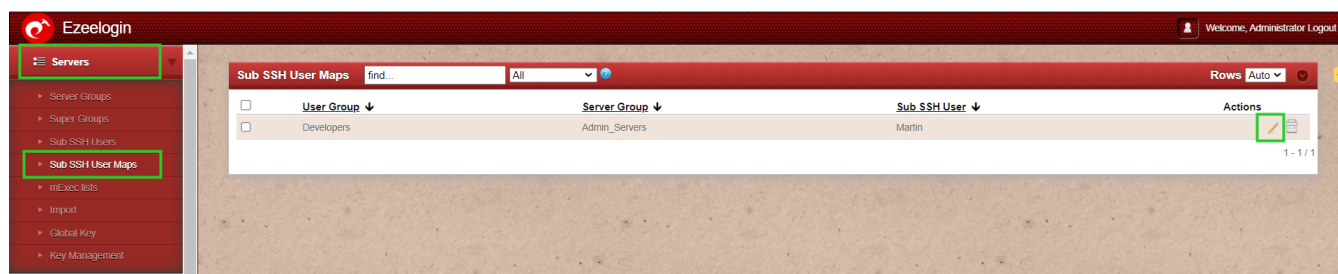

- Click under **Server** section -> **Sub SSH User Maps** -> **Edit** -> **Change Group of Sub SSH user**.
