How to list the usernames and the corresponding subssh users mapped individually?

Overview: This article helps to retrieve the list of gateway users and their corresponding subssh users configured in Ezeelogin.

Step 1: Run below command to find the database name and table prefix.

```
root@gateway:~# cat /usr/local/etc/ezlogin/ez.conf | grep -i
"db_name|db_prefix"

db_name ezlogin_wupluh
db_prefix btu_
```

Step 2: Login to the MySQL and run the query below to list the usernames and the corresponding subssh users mapped individually from the user edit.

with a single command.

```
root@gateway:~# mysql -u root -p -e "USE $(grep -oP 'db_names+KS+'
/usr/local/etc/ezlogin/ez.conf);select u.username as user, s.username
as sub_ssh_user from $(grep -oP 'db_prefixs+KS+'
/usr/local/etc/ezlogin/ez.conf)users as u join $(grep -oP
'db_prefixs+KS+' /usr/local/etc/ezlogin/ez.conf)ssh_users as s on
u.ssh_user_id = s.id;"
