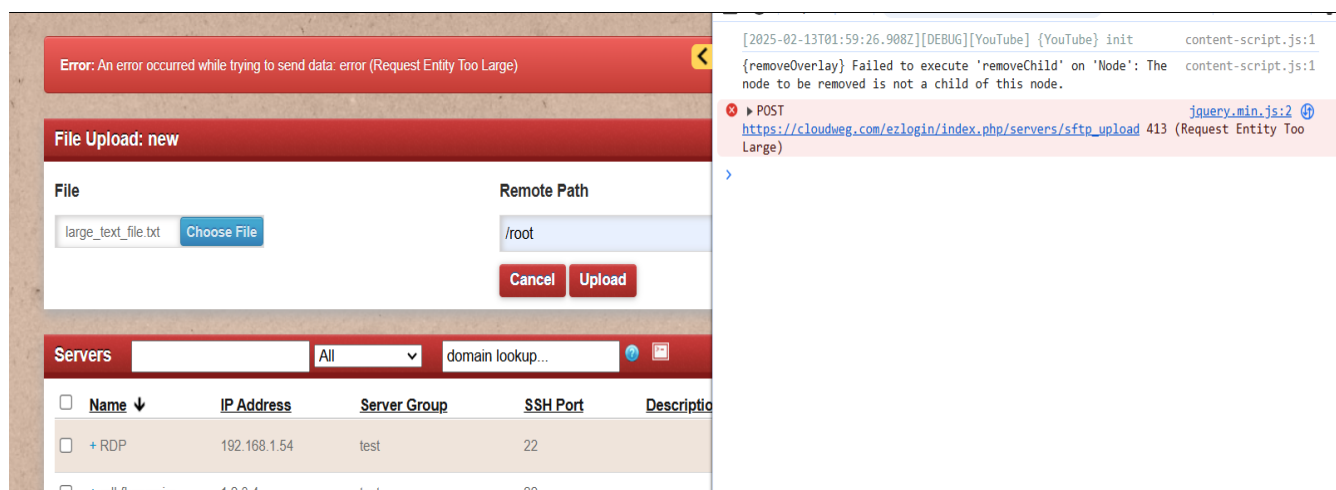

## How to resolve an Error: An error occurred while trying to send data: error (Request Entity Too Large)

**Overview:** This article describes how to resolve the *Error: An error occurred while trying to send data: error (Request Entity Too Large)* while uploading files from desktop machine to remote server.



On Ubuntu Server,

**Step 1:** To resolve the above error, add LimitRequestBody parameter with default value in apache conf file. Refer to the steps below.

```
root@gateway :~# vi /etc/apache2/apache2.conf
```

```
LimitRequestBody 0
```

**Step 2:** Restart the webserver and access Ezeelogin GUI.

```
root@gateway :~# systemctl restart apache2
```
