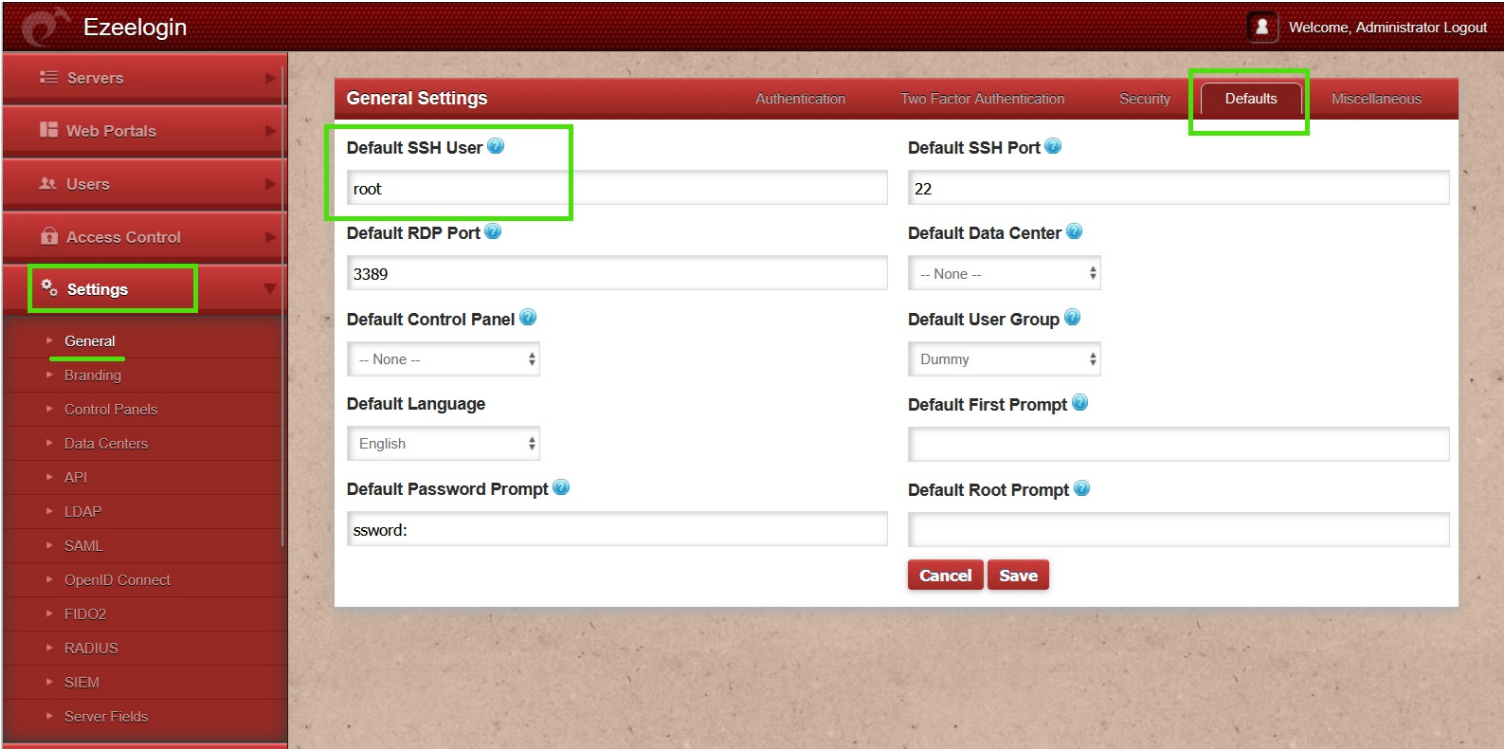


Default SSH user

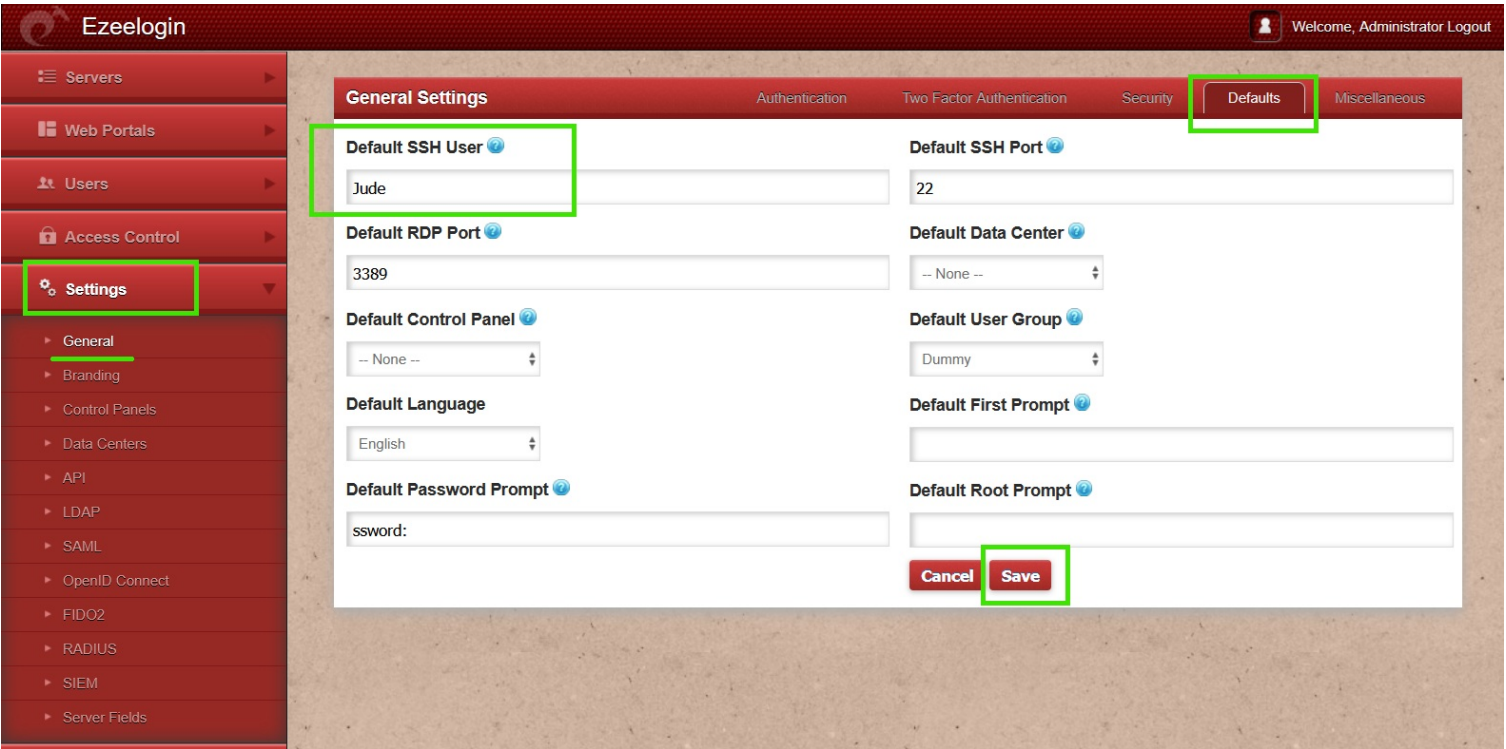
How to set default ssh user in Ezeelogin

Overview: This article provides guidance on setting a default SSH user in the Ezeelogin GUI, ensuring the specified username is automatically applied when adding new servers.

To set the default SSH user, navigate to **Settings -> General -> Defaults -> Default SSH User**. This will be auto-filled by default when adding a server.



Setting a different username (e.g., Jude) here will automatically reflect when adding a server in the Ezeelogin GUI.
