How to resolve ezsh segfault error or ezsh shell crashes without error messages, causing you to be logged out of the Ezeelogin backend?

Overview: The article outlines troubleshooting steps to resolve EZSH shell crashes and segfault errors, focusing on checking resource limits, whitelisting the binary in security software, and reviewing specific log files for error details.

Step 1: This is most likely occurring because of resource shortages. Ensure that there is enough memory on the server. Raise the memory limits on the server and reboot.

Step 2: Also, make sure that security software like <u>CloudLinux</u> is not blocking the **/usr/local/bin/ezsh** binary, if yes, ensure to whitelist it.

Step 3: Check for the <u>logs</u> for any errors messages
